

## Groom Lake Pendant

Make this "technical", donut-shaped pendant with Matubo NIB-BIT beads

1) String one Miniduo,
 one NB (narrow end), one Miniduo, one NB (narrow end) ... total 12 of each.
2) Slide all the beads to the end of the thread. Tie a square knot to form a circle, then pass through the upper hole of the nearest Miniduo.

3) Add one NB (narrow end) and pass through the upper hole of the next Miniduo.
4) Repeat step 3 ..

5) Repeat steps 7 and 8 ...


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11) Pass through the nearest group of four 15/0s ...
12) ... and then pass through the upper hole of the next "unused" NB bead ...
13) .... and then pass through the next four 15/0s...

15) Repeat steps 11 14, until you reach the end of the row.
14) ... and then again through the upper hole of the next "unused" NB bead.

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21) Add two $15 / 0 \mathrm{~s}$, one $11 / 0$, one $8 / 0$, one $11 / 0$ and two 15/Os and pass through the next 11/0 on the opposite side of the ring.

22) And again ... add two 15/0s, one 11/0, one 8/0, one 11/0 and two 15/0s and pass through the next 11/0 on the opposite side of the ring.
23) Repeat steps 21 and 22, until you reach the end of the row.

25) Add two 15/0s and pass through the nearest "unused" 11/0.
24) Pass through the first two 15/0s, 11/0, $8 / 0$ and $11 / 0$ you added in this row.

26) Add two 15/0s and pass through the nearest (11/0, 8/0, 11/0) in the row.

27) Repeat steps 25 and 26 ...
28) Until you reach the end of the row.

The thread should exit from one of the (11/0, 8/0, 11/0) groups.

29) Add one 6/0 and pass through the next (11/0, 8/0, 11/0) group
30) Repeat step 29, until you reach the end of the row. At the end of the row make the step-up by passing through the last $(11 / 0,8 / 0,11 / 0)$ group and through the first $6 / 0$ in the row.


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31) Add one 8/0, one NB (narrow end) and one 8/0 and pass through the next 6/0.

32) Repeat step 31, until you reach the end of the row.

37) Make the step-up by passing through the first 8/0 in this row.

33) At the end of the row pass through the first (8/0, NB, 8/0) you added in this row.

34) Add one 8/0 and pass through the next (8/0, NB, 8/0) group in the row.

35) Repeat step 34 ...

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43) Repeat step 42, until you reach the end of the row.

45) Add two 15/0s and pass through the upper hole of the next NB bead.

46) Repeat steps 44 and 45 , until you reach the end of the row.
47) The thread exits from one of the NB beads.

Add four 15/0s and one 11/0 and pass through the nearest 6/0. Pull snug.

48) Add one $11 / 0$ and four $15 / 0$ s and pass through the upper hole of the next NB bead.


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49) Repeat steps 47 and 48, until you reach the end of the row.

50) The pendant is finished. Tie a few half-hitch knots and cut off all the remaining thread.
51) Attach a bail under
