

## Rani Bracelet

Simple, but stunning. A piece of jewelry fit for a queen


Material (for one bracelet):

Matubo NIB-BIT (approx. 40 pcs) Matubo 8/0 (approx. 40 pcs) Matubo Miniduo (approx. 40 pcs) 11/0 Japanese seed beads (approx. 2,5 grams) Miyuki Delica 11/0 (approx. 1-2 grams) Jump rings, a piece of jewelry chain, a clasp Beading needle and thread (Nymo, Fireline)

8mm chatons, cabochons or Rivolis (optional) 15/0 Miyuki seed beads (optional)

Difficulty: For beginners

[^0]1) String one Miniduo, one NB (narrow side), one Miniduo, one NB ... total four of each.
2) Slide all the beads to the end of the thread and tie a square knot to form a circle.
Then pass through the upper hole (wide end) of the nearest NB bead.

3) Add one 11/0 and pass through the upper hole (wide side) of the next NB.
4) Repeat steps 3 and 4, until you reach the end of the row.

5) Add one 11/0, one 8/0 and one 11/0 and then pass through the next 11/0 in the row, then through the upper hole (wide side) of the NB bead ...

11) ... and then through one more 11/0.
12) Repeat steps 10 and 11 ...
13) ... until you reach
the end of the row.

14) Weave through the last row one more time - but always skip the 8/0 in the corner.

15) Tie a few half-
hitch knots and cut off all the remaining thread.

Repeat steps 1 - 15 to make another component.


16) For a bracelet, you will need approximately 10 components. Connect them by jump rings and the 8/0 beads in the corners.
17) Attach a clasp, using jump rings and two little pieces of jewelry chain.

Bonus: Chaton/cabochon bezel


These bracelet components look great just on their own, but thanks to NIB-BIT's unique shape, they make a great base for a chaton/cabochon/rivoli bezel.
So if you want to add a little bit of bling to your bracelet...
... prepare an 8 mm cabochon, rivoli or a chaton and a little bit of $15 / 0$ Miyuki seed beads.

18) Make another component by repeating steps 1 - 14.

The thread should exit from one of the NB beads.
Pass through the next Delica bead in the row.
19) Add one new Delica, then pass through the next Delica in the row.
20) Add five $15 / 0$ s and

22) ... until you reach the end of the row.
23) Weave through beads to get to the "middle" 15/0 from the first group of five $15 / 0$ s you added in the previous row.

24) Add five $15 / 0$ s and pass through the middle 15/0 from the next group od 15/0s in the row.

25) Repeat step 24 ...


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26) ... until you reach the end of the row.

Before you finish the row, put the chaton inside.

27) Weave through all the four groups of five 15/Os you added in this row. Keep your tension very tight.

28) Tie a few square knots and cut off all the remaining thread.
